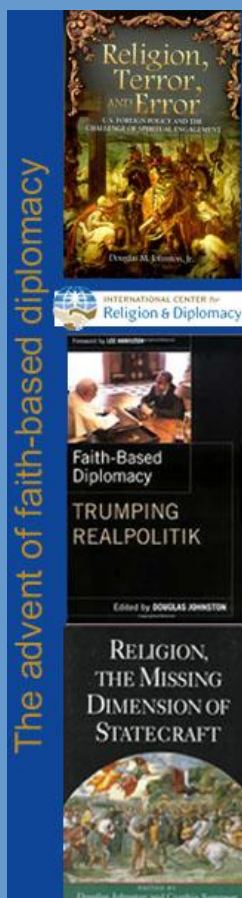

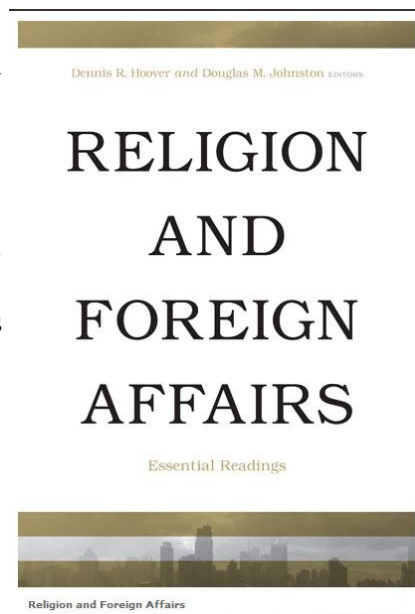

New Book Features World-Class Scholars on Religion and Diplomacy

Some months ago, ICRD partnered with the Institute for Global Engagement (IGE) to produce a comprehensive reader on the role of religion in international affairs, which has just been published by Baylor University Press. IGE is a fellow NGO that develops sustainable environments for religious freedom in various parts of the world. The intent behind this unique compendium titled *Religion and Foreign Affairs: Essential Readings* is to provide academicians and practitioners alike with a broad selection of penetrating articles by world-class scholars on religion and global politics that span generations, cultures, and world views—from St. Augustine and Thucydides on the one hand to Reinhold Niebuhr and Peter Berger on the other (and numerous others in between).
