**Robert C. McFarlane** was the National Security Advisor to President Ronald Reagan from 1983 to 1985. A Marine Corp veteran, he commanded the artillery battery of the first landing of US combat forces in Vietnam in 1965. Mr. McFarlane is President of the Institute for the Analysis of Global Security.



**Michael J. Rogers** is Chairman of the House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence. A veteran of the U.S. Army and the FBI, Congressman Rogers has represented Michigan's 8th Congressional district since 2001 and was named Chairman of the Intelligence Committee in 2011. He also serves on the Energy and Commerce Committee.

At the dinner, we will be honoring both **Imam Feisal Rauf** and **Daisy Khan** with this year's Faith-in-Action Award. Imam Rauf is a world-class leader in interfaith peacebuilding, and Ms. Khan is a global champion of women's empowerment in Islam.
