Looking Inward



How Muslims are treated in the United States has consequences that extend beyond the need to protect every citizen's civil liberties. Any perception that the American Muslim community is being persecuted or even marginalized plays directly into the hands of the extremists. A recent Gallup Poll [report](#) indicates that over 48% of Muslims living in America have experienced religious discrimination at some level, a vastly higher percentage than any other religion within our borders.

To address this concern, ICRD in partnership with [Peace Catalyst International](#) and the [Dialogue Institute](#) at Temple University will be conducting a conference for evangelical pastors and other religious leaders in early October on **Religious Freedom and Islamophobia**.
